



Following the recent court case involving a golfer who was seriously injured by a stray shot, at a course in West Lothian, which resulted in damages of £400,000 being awarded to the claimant (70% payable by the golfer, 30% by the club) all golfers are reminded that **it is their own personal responsibility** to ensure they have adequate insurance cover for such an accident.

All golfers are reminded to exercise care when playing, pay attention to advisory notices and to take all reasonable steps to prevent injury to other persons on the golf courses and their surrounds.
